- Are you ever sad and you don't know why?
- Do you ever have a feeling of restlessness?
- Do you sometimes have trouble sleeping?
- Are you unable to focus on a task?
- Do you have trouble remembering?
- Do you seem to be angry for no reason?
- Do you occasionally find yourself in tears?
- Have you lost interest in the usual social events?
- Do you spend too much time eating or sleeping?
- Have you started to drink more alcohol?

If you answered 'YES' to any of these questions, you may be grieving a loss in your life. A loss could be a death, the loss of a job, a home, transition into retirement, or 'empty-next' syndrome, where your child(ren) have left home. Some people are grieving the loss of good health, or a good friend who has moved away. Sometimes, you just need to tell your story, share your grief, and just have someone to listen! Come to the Grief Support Group – we will listen. Everything will remain **confidential.** Our parishioner, **Susan Johnston, M.S**., a certified counselor, will be there to listen.

#### The Group will meet in the St. Anthony Schoolhouse Saturday mornings from 11:30 am to 12:30 pm on June 5, 12, 26, July 10 and 17.
