From Barbara...

"We have come to do him homage." The story of the magi tells us of people searching and traveling great distances to celebrate the birth of Jesus. In comparison, we have it much easier than our ancestors in faith. We have many opportunities to celebrate the sacraments and to worship with our faith community. We rarely have to travel great distances and be inconvenienced to such an extent. Take time this week to notice how your faith life would be different if you had to really go out of your way to practice what you believe.

Next Saturday, January 8, we will be having a Christmas Lessons and Carols service and potluck supper. This will be a great opportunity to end the Christmas season with readings about salvation history leading up to the birth of Jesus and the beautiful music of all of our various music ministry groups. This will be followed by a potluck supper where we can share our blessings with our fellow parishioners. I hope you will find time to join us for this service. Details can be found elsewhere in the bulletin.

Just a reminder about our snow policy for weekday masses: if schools in Frederick County are closed or delayed we will not have daily Mass. We do this for a variety of reasons. The first is that if the county department of safety has determined that the roads are not safe, we do not want people on the roads risking themselves and others to come to Mass. In addition if an accident should happen, we could be impeding the ability of the county to clear the roads so that others can use them. I understand that attending daily Mass is an important part of someone's prayer life but we want to make sure that all are safe. Also, we need to have a consistent policy because some family members may want to attend the Mass if the intention that day is for their loved one. If a Mass is cancelled, the intention is moved to another day and the family is notified. Thanks for your understanding and patience.
