AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 13 OF THE CODE OF EMMITSBURG ENTITLED GARBAGE COLLECTION

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Emmitsburg, Maryland that Chapters 13.16.020 of the Emmitsburg Municipal Code be, and it hereby is, amended as follows:

The amended section of this regulation reads as follows with new language designated by being in **BOLD CAPITAL LETTERS**, and language being deleted designated by being stricken through.

Chapter 13.16

GARBAGE COLLECTION

Section 13.16.020 Collection Regulations and Information

- A. Collection of garbage from all residential units shall be performed ONCE PER twice a week. Should this day fall on a national holiday, service FOR THE CURRENT WEEK will be DETERMINED BY THE CURRENT CONTRACTOR provided on the next regularly scheduled pickup day.
- B. Garbage cans and/or bags shall be placed either at the curb line or edge of street for pickup. All cans must be securely covered and bags must be tightly tied. Trash cans are recommended.
- C. Garbage must not sit out along the curb line or edge of street for an extended period of time. Garbage shall be placed out for collection no sooner than twelve (12) hours prior to pickup.
- D. Collection of garbage shall not be made on Main Street (Maryland Route 140), except in those instances when a residential unit is not accessible from North Avenue or Lincoln Avenue.
- E. The following will not be picked up at curbside as trash: brush, grass clippings or other vegetative matter, bundled newspapers, construction materials of any kind bagged or unbagged.
- F. Household furniture and/or appliances will not be picked up as trash.

- G. Multiunit buildings must supply a trash collection area. The trash collection area must have a hard surface floor (concrete or asphalt) and a solid frame fence, with latchable gate, not less than forty-eight (48) inches tall. Trash collection areas must include eighteen (18) square feet of area per unit serviced, but not less than sixty-four (64) square feet of total area. Trash from the multiunit building will be stored in garbage cans (recommended) and/or bags at the trash collection area prior to trash pickup. Multiunit buildings may use a trash dumpster in place of a trash collection area if the following requirements are met:
 - 1. Dumpster must be approved by the town and contractor as adequate for the intended use;
 - 2. A dumpster pad must be supplied by owner of the dumpster and/or property owner and be approved by the town.
