## **Town Manager's Report**

## **NOVEMBER 2010**

### Streets:

- Staff worked with Craig Paving to mill and repave West and East Lincoln Avenue.
- Staff repaired a number of street lights.
- Staff installed "snow flags" on fire hydrants.
- Staff hung the swags on the light poles and decorated the Christmas tree at the Community Center.

### Water:

- Rainbow Lake is flowing over the spillway level (up 14" from last month).
- The roughing filters are being backwashed twice per day and the DE filters are being done twice per week.
- The water levels in our wells are 7.6' lower than May of this year (down 4.6' from last month).
- Water production and consumption. We produced and purchased an average of 327,429 GPD. We consumed an average of 262,469 GPD. (down 33,652 GPD or 134 taps from May, ALSO DOWN 75,691 GPD OR 302 TAPS FROM LAST MONTH)

The difference is "Backwash Water" ... (19.8%). We purchased 963,025 gallons of water from MSM this month.

- o 41.9% of this water came from wells.
- o 9.8% of this water came from Mt. St. Mary's.
- o 48.3% of this water came from Rainbow Lake.

# • HEAVY RAINS STIRRED UP THE WATER IN RAIBOW LAKE REQUIRING ADDITIONAL BACKWASHING OF THE FILTERS

### Wastewater:

- The overland and flow treatment system is up and running for the season.
- The water and sewer systems superintendent performed several grease trap site inspections this month.
- We received about 5.9 inches of precipitation this month (the average is 3.8 inches).
  - We have a precipitation surplus of 2.4" over the last six months. The average precipitation for the period from June 1 thru November 30 is 23.1". We have received 25.5" for that period.
- Wastewater Treatment:

- o We treated an average of 440,000 GPD (consumed 262,469 GPD) which means that 40.3% of the wastewater treated this month was "wild water".
- We exceeded the plant's design capacity on two days during the month of November:
  - 11/16 1,595,000 GPD
  - 11/17 1,273,000 GPD

## Trash:

• Trash pickup will remain Mondays for the remainder of month of December and recycling will be picked up on Friday, December 24, 2010.

## Parks:

- Staff has been mowing, trimming and performing general maintenance in the parks.
- Staff has winterized all of the restrooms in the parks.
- Staff cleaned and painted over graffiti on the Community Park restrooms.
