## **Town Manager's Report**

# FEBRUARY 2011

#### Streets:

- Staff installed "speed bump" signs in Emmit Gardens.
- Staff repaired a number of street lights.
- Staff plowed and salted streets and sidewalks.
- Staff "cold patched" a number of pot holes.

### Water:

- Rainbow Lake is flowing over the spillway level.
- The roughing filters are being backwashed twice per day and the DE filters are being done once per week.
- Staff replaced a chemical feed pump at the water treatment plant.
- The water levels in our wells are now less than 3' lower than May 2010.
- Water production and consumption. We produced and purchased an average of 294,606 GPD. We consumed an average of 263,534 GPD.

The difference is "Backwash Water"  $\dots$  (10.5%). We purchased 313,500 gallons of water from MSM this month.

- o 39.0% of this water came from wells.
- o 3.8% of this water came from Mt. St. Mary's.
- o 57.2% of this water came from Rainbow Lake.

#### Wastewater:

- The overland flow treatment system is up and running for the season.
- Staff repaired the manhole frame and cover of the electric manhole for Lagoon No. 1.
- We received about 3.4 inches of precipitation this month (the average is 3.0 inches).
  - We have a precipitation **DEFICIT** of 4.2" over the last six months. The average precipitation for the period from September 1 thru February 28 is 21.5". We have received 17.3" for that period.
- Wastewater Treatment:
  - We treated an average of 649,000 GPD (consumed 263,534 GPD) which means that 59.4% of the wastewater treated this month was "wild water".
  - We did exceed the plant's design capacity eight (8) days during the month of February:
